New Tuition Policies:

Cash Discount: Pay monthly tuition with cash/check on or before the 1st of the month and receive Early Bird pricing on that month's tuition!

Pay in Full Discounts: Pay the entire 9 months on or before first class in September and receive 5% off your yearly tuition! This only applies to September payments.

Half-year Payments: Pay the first half of the year on or before the first class in September and receive 2.5% off tuition. (Second payment is due by January 10th to receive the 2.5% discount on remaining tuition.)

Families Registering in October: Pay full or half year tuition and we will waive the \$2 monthly service fee.

*All credit card payments will be charged a 4% convenience fee

*Discounts cannot be combined

*Tuition is based on total hours per family

*Returned check fees are \$35. Should a check be returned, we request that all subsequent payments be made by credit card, cash, or money order.

Tuition

Tuition is prorated and priced for the full 9-month dance season and may be paid for the year, half year, or on a monthly payment plan. Therefore, monthly fees are the same regardless of the number of weeks each month. Tuition is always due the first class of the month and no later than the 10th of each month, *even if the 10th falls on a holiday or a day we are closed. A late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed to all accounts paid after the 10th of the month.* Tuition is due regardless of attendance: The school does not deduct for illness, vacations or absences. We encourage students to make up classes. See our full handbook for complete details.

Tuition may be paid in-studio, mailed, or for your convenience, online via our Customer Portal (you can download the app or access through our website: www.jamesdancepac.com, click "portal," then "account login." This will redirect you to our Customer Portal. Login using the email you provided at registration, create a password, and agree to policies. You will be able to access your dancer's classes, billing history, and studio announcements.

Costume Fees: Costumes for the spring performance need to be purchased by each student. *There are no refunds on costume deposits once costumes are ordered.* Ordering begins in December to ensure costume arrival by picture date. **All costume balances and tuition payments must be current before costumes will be distributed.** Costume fees are made in two payments: one in October or November and the second in January or February, with any additional accessory (bows, socks, etc.) or prop fees billed later. The amount of the first deposit is \$75.00 for *each* costume. All costume balances must be paid for in full once ordered. There are no returns or refunds.

What to Wear: We are a professional dance training facility, therefore dancers are expected to wear the appropriate dancewear for their specific level. Dancewear will be available for purchase exclusively from our online boutique, shopnimbly.com/jamesdancepac. A complete list of items will be available upon registration.

Class Change/Drop Fees: Requests for class changes/withdrawal must be submitted in writing. Requests made after October 31st will be charged a \$10 class change/drop fee per class. Forms are available at the front desk.

ALL CREDIT/DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS ARE ASSESSED A 4% CONVENIENCE FEE.

James Dance & PAC continues to follow all state mandates regarding health and welfare. We ask that all families and dancers respect guidelines.

Student Rules:

(Dancers and families are expected to follow all rules while using our facility)

1. We shall not chew gum.
2. We shall not bring food or drink into the classroom.
3. We shall wear proper attire in class.
4. We shall not talk while the teacher is talking.
5. We shall not talk while dancing.
6. We shall *not* use our cell phones during class times.
7. We shall *not* sit down during class unless specifically permitted or instructed to do so.
8. We shall speak respectfully to the teachers and to one another
9. We shall use 100% of our energies while in class.
10. We will not miss class except for valid reasons.
11. We will not run recklessly around the reception area and classrooms.
12. We will wait *inside* the studio for our ride.

*Email is our primary form of communication. Announcements are also posted on the studio Eboard.

Lobby Rules:

****For the safety of everyone, if you or your child are not feeling well, please stay at home. We will contact the parent of any child with a fever over 100.4 and request they be picked up.****

Entering the Studio: Please use hand sanitizer upon entering the studio. All patrons must remove street shoes before entering the classrooms. Dancers should only bring a dance bag containing shoes for class and a water bottle. All belongings will Exit using the door in the desk area.

Lobby: Our lobby is now open to JDPAC Families however, we request that families be mindful and courteous of others. Please consider waiting outside during more pleasant weather and allow us to escort dancers out after class. Limit the number of family members you bring into the studio. Do not gather in walkways or doorways. Parents are not typically permitted in classrooms unless invited. Shoes must be removed and carried inside the classrooms.

Restroom: Please remind your dancer to use the restroom before class. The girl's restroom is designated for student use. Only one person is permitted in the restroom. Because of restrictions, this restroom is also designated as a family restroom. The men's room is for staff-use only.

Study and Lunchroom: The study/lunchroom is now located in the coat area of the lobby. All food is to be consumed in this area only. Students must remain seated while eating. Parents and students are responsible for clean-up. Students may bring a water bottle to take in the classroom, but no Gatorade, soda, or drinks with straws are permitted in the studio area. **NO food is permitted in any other part of the studio including restrooms and classrooms.**

Lost and Found: *We do not have a "Lost and Found."* Please make certain your dancer has all their belongings before leaving. **Label all belongings, especially shoes.** Please do not bring extra items (toys, clothing, electronics, etc). JDPAC is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

Teacher Contact: If you need to speak with your child's teacher, we ask that you make an appointment at the front desk. Due to scheduling, teachers are unable to meet between classes, but they will gladly schedule an appointment to go over any questions you may have.

JDPAC Electronics Policy: The use of electronics (cell phones, tablets, etc) in the classroom without teacher permission is prohibited. Electronics should remain in dance bags.

Upon registration, it is understood that all families agree to the policies set forth by James Dance & Performing Arts Center. This includes all payment policies, costuming, attendance, dress requirements, etc.
